We are pleased to inform you that the Scout Association of Mongolia is hosting the **31st Asia-Pacific Regional Scout Jamboree** at "Nairamdal" International Children's Center, Ulaanbaatar City, Capital of Mongolia from **27th July 2017 to 02nd August, 2017.**

In this Jamboree, Scouts gathered from all over the World will be actively discuss and think about the global issues such as Peace, and reflect their life through various programmes which are prepared for their development. Friendship fostered in 31st APR Scout Jamboree will flourish far into the future.

Like previous Jamborees, Bharat Scouts & Guides will be participating with a large Contingent in this Jamboree also. Hence, we are pleased to invite Scouts & Guides, Rovers & Rangers and Adult Leaders to be a part this gala event.

Details as follows:

Name of the Event	: 31 ST ASIA-PACIFIC REGIONAL SCOUT JAMBOREE-2017.
Dates	: 27 th July 2017 to 02 nd August, 2017.
Theme	: "Go Nomad"
Jamboree Mascot	: Jamboree Mascot represents each educational objectives of the Scouting such as physical, social, spiritual, intellectual, emotional development and become person him or herself.
Venue	: "Nairamdal" International Children's Center, Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia (Chinggis Khaan International airport will be the main points of entry by air)
Date of Arrival	: (1) Participants Arrival - 26 th July 2017 morning (2) ISTs Arrival - 24 th July 2017 morning
Date of Departure	: (1) Participants Departure Day - 02 nd August 2017 morning (2) IST Departure Day - 03 rd August morning
Eligibility for Participation	: (A) Participants - Male and Female (Scouts & Guides) aged 12 to 17 years old at the start of the Jamboree are eligible to take part in 31 st APR Scout Jamboree as participants. With each Patrol (09 members) one Adult Leader will be allowed.


	<p>(B) International Service Team (IST): Rovers & Rangers who are at least 18 years of age at the start of the Jamboree are welcome to join the IST. (Over 55 years are not eligible) IST should be able to communicate in English and be ready to perform any tasks necessary for the Jamboree. In addition, they are expected to be available from the evening of the 25 July 2017 until afternoon of the 3 August 2017. The IST members are expected to work hard and fulfill a vital role in terms of motivating and supporting participants and providing services, programme and facilities. Some roles may require long working hours or working at night. All ISTs will be camping in the Adult Camp Area located in the South Western part of the Jamboree site. IST will attend the Jamboree as part of a National Contingent.</p> <p>Note: Selection of IST will strictly be decided by the National Headquarters in the ratio 9:1. No Individual application of IST will be accepted without participants i.e. Scouts & Guides.</p>
Accommodation	: All Participants and ISTs have to carry their own individual tents for accommodation. ISTs cannot share tents with the participants. Male & Female accommodation will be separate, hence arrange tents accordingly.
Highlights	: The 31 st APR Scout Jamboree programme highlights are as chance to Mongolian and overseas participants to exchange their experiences and let scouts learn about Mongolian culture and history. There will be various kinds of interesting activities organized every day such as Pioneering, Craft Workshop, hiking around resort area, mountain trail, traditional games, Wrestling, Archery, Horse-racing, Global Development Village and many more.
Jamboree Fee	: <p>For Participants: USD 200.00 per person (INR 14,000/- approximately including bank transfer) – The fee covers food, local transportation from the airport to the Jamboree site & participant's kit.</p> <p>For IST: For Participants: USD 180.00 per person (INR 13,000/- approximately including bank transfer) – The fee covers food, local transportation from the airport to the Jamboree site & participant's kit.</p>
Climate	: Mongolia's land of temperature extremes. The average annual temperature in Mongolia ranges from – 16°C (-2°F) in February to a more comfortable 16°C (62°F) in July. Summer fades quickly, and by September the annual average temperature drops to 8°C (48°F)
Air-fare and Visa charges	: New Delhi ⇌ Mongolia – INR. 80,000/- (Approximately) subject to actual. The rates may vary at the time of booking,
Caution Money	: Rs. 5000/- , Non-refundable; if selected and not participated. <i>Demand Draft in the name of "Bharat Scouts & Guides", payable at New Delhi</i>

Last Date of Application	: As the quota is limited, selection will be on the basis of "FIRST COME FIRST SERVE" The applications of the participating candidates should reach National Headquarters, New Delhi on or before 30th June 2016 along with photocopy of valid passport. Applications will not be accepted without Valid Passport.
