Dates	: 05 th to 09 th October, 2016 (Arrival on early morning of 5 th October, Wednesday and departure on late night of 9 th October, Friday)
Venue	: Tsukuba International Congress Center, Ibaraki, Japan.
Participants	: This workshop is proposed to gather a maximum of 40 national and sub-national level leaders who are involved/ responsible for/have interest in the area of disaster management. Should be ready to accept the role of NSO coordinator and committed to further strengthen the NSO capacity and able to establish local network.
Aim of the Workshop	: To bring understanding on the nature of global risks, identify the best preventive measures in disaster management, and how best to prepare for, respond to and recover from disasters locally and internationally.



Methods	:	Talk, Panel Presentation, Case Presentation and Study, Project Workgroups.
Workshop Fee	:	Participation fee is USD \$ 150.00 covers inland transport, Food (from lunch on 5 th October to lunch on 9 th October) and accommodation during the event (check-in on 5 th October and check out on 9 th October) and programme materials.
Air-fare and Visa charges	:	New Delhi ⇌ Japan – INR. 55,000/- (Approximately)
