

Dates and Venue:

The training is taking place at Pax Lodge from 26th April – 1st May 2015. Accommodation will be supplied from 26th April – 1st May 2015 and participants need to attend all five full days. Departures will be on Saturday 2nd May 2015. Please note, there is no accommodation available at Pax Lodge prior to 26th April.

Goal and objectives:

In May 2013 WAGGGS held a flagship national leadership development training at Pax Lodge. The aim of the event was to train trainers from Member Organisations in the new National Leadership Development Programme (NLDP) and deliver elements of the WAGGGS Leadership Development Programme (WLDP) at National level to member organizations. It was an exciting and significant phase in WAGGGS programme of Leadership Development. The event trained trainers using the methods, philosophy and approach of the WLDP. It laid the foundation for strengthening trainer's skills and developing strategies for delivering the NLDP in their countries and reaching out to more WAGGGS members. Throughout 2014, regional NLDP events have taken place in the Western Hemisphere, the Arab and the Africa Region.

Through the NLDP WAGGGS are supporting member organizations in building their leadership capacity. Developing individuals to utilize their personal skills and abilities to further the movement in their countries and empower leaders throughout WAGGGS.

The aim in 2015-2017 is to roll out the National Leadership Development Programme (NLDP) as extensively as possible to MOs across all regions and to do so we need to develop and build the pool of NLDP Trainers at a WAGGGS level. This will enable WAGGGS to extend the NLDP to more Member Organisations around the world, in turn building stronger, resilient associations.

Through the generosity of OBPS, we are able to provide a Facilitators Training in 2015, to build capacity in trainer's delivering the NLDP and WAGGGS projects generally. The recent UPS funding means that we can also prepare trainers in identified UPS countries with the skills and competence needed to deliver a successful NLDP project in their country.

We are looking for experienced trainers, facilitators and key volunteers with a strong background in training, facilitation and leadership to undertake the training to become a WAGGGS NLDP Trainers. This role would entail attending a five day Facilitators training in April at Pax Lodge and then committing to delivering at least two NLDP events between 2015-2016. This commitment would mean supporting, and contributing to the planning and delivery of NLDP events in their Associations and implementing a UPS country project (if funded by UPS).

The training will combine a general WAGGGS facilitators training and how to deliver a NLDP training at a national level.

Who?

- All experienced national trainers, facilitators and active WLDP facilitators are welcome to apply
- Trainers who have a second language in French, Spanish or Arabic.
- Previously trained NLDP Trainers

All who apply will need to ensure they have the support of their Association (if applicable), especially in the commitment to the on-going delivery and implementation of the NLDP. They should also ensure they have the relevant skills and expertise and availability to undertake the commitment.

The WAGGGS Leadership Team will also work with the regional teams to recommend participants and key volunteers who they feel can bring the expertise, knowledge and skills that would make a valuable contribution as a future NLDP Trainer..

Criteria for applying:

Essential

- Available to be at Pax Lodge for the Facilitators training from 26th April – 1st May 2015
- Able to commit to two NLDP events from 2015 through to the beginning of 2017 (dates and locations to be agreed between WAGGGS and the trained facilitators at a later stage)
- Experience in delivering non-formal and or formal training to groups of adult learners
- Knowledge and experience of the full training cycle
- Experience of training methodology and design of non-formal learning experiences
- A good understanding of training in your country or region
- Knowledge of current leadership theory and trends, either through a leadership role or through studies
- A genuine interest and passion in developing others
- An openness to new ideas and new ways of working as a trainer
- Confidence to work in cross cultural settings
- Open and willing to work in diverse teams
- Ability to be flexible and handle change
- Tolerant and culturally sensitive
- Able to engage people and provide a safe space for learning
- A flexible and creative approach to delivering training
- Able to use relevant technologies to communicate

Desirable

- Ability to speak French, Spanish or Arabic fluently, or well enough to deliver a training in the language in country
- Previous experience of delivering leadership training
- Experience of working as a trainer regionally or internationally
- Experience of supporting a WAGGGS leadership event
- Experience of training others to train

Other important information:

- The training will be conducted in English with language support in French, Spanish and Arabic.
- Sending an application does not guarantee your participation. We will make the selection of participants on the basis of the essential skills, expertise and experience required.
- Please be aware that there will be a requirement to access the GLOW platform to do some preparation for the event. *You will need good access to the internet and a reliable connection.*
- If you need a visa it is your responsibility to obtain one. Please do this as soon as your application is approved. WAGGGS will provide you with a letter upon request to support your visa application.
- WAGGGS will be fully funding the Facilitators training and this will include flights and accommodation.
